



## CANADA'S PRIMA BALLERINA EMBARKS ON 2016 CANADIAN MASTERCLASS SERIES

Unique Opportunity Provides Aspiring Canadian Dancers with World-Class Instruction

**February 2016 – Vancouver, Canada:** Chan Hon Goh, Director of the Goh Ballet and former Principal Dancer of the National Ballet of Canada is heading across Canada for her annual Canadian Masterclass Series beginning February 6<sup>th</sup> in Calgary, Alberta.

Following the success of the inaugural Masterclass Series in 2014, Ms. Chan Hon Goh will be visiting eight cities across Canada providing a rare opportunity for aspiring dancers. Performers ages 10 to 18 will be mentored in small groups by Goh, one of Canada's dance elite. The tour commences at Calgary's School of Alberta Ballet and concludes on February 23, 2016 at the Northern Lights School of Dance in Whitehorse, YT.

"I would like to continue on this important journey, which started in 2014, to create access for young dancers across the vast Canadian dance community to receive instruction which will propel their artistry and benefit their future goals," Ballerina Chan Hon Goh explains. "My Masterclass is a chance for me to inspire and mentor future artists to achieve their dance dreams. It is a very intensive month but we are thrilled to reach young dancers across the country, to foster and grow the incredible dance community in Canada. It gives me so much joy to be able to meet aspiring artists, their enthusiasm and talent continue to engage my desire to give back."

The Masterclass will be hosted in eight cities including Calgary, Toronto, Ottawa, Edmonton, Kelowna, Vancouver, Nanaimo and Whitehorse. (full schedule below).
